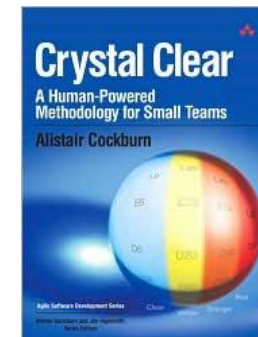
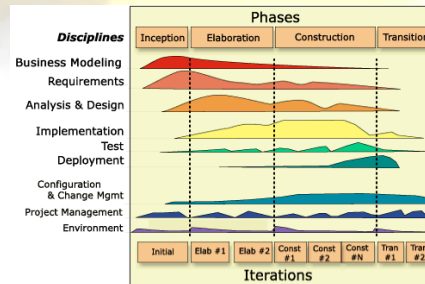
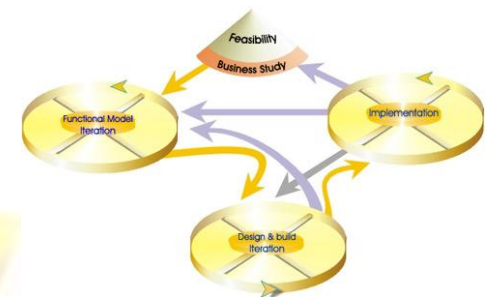
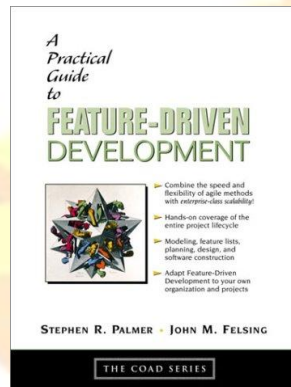
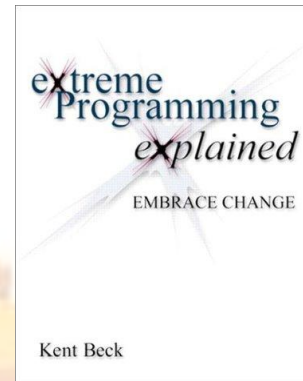
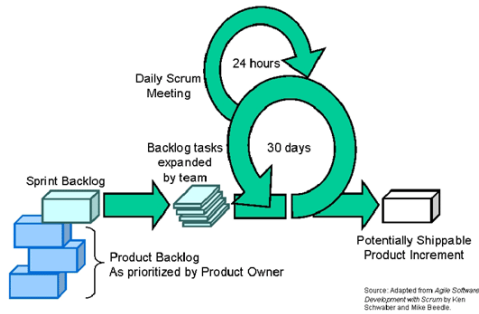


Manifesto for Agile Software Development
